Third-Party Monitoring (TPM) refers to the use of an independent monitoring agent to follow and assess projects that are considered high-risk or contentious, or where access may be difficult and dangerous.

Baseline, Midline, and Endline Surveys

Baseline, midline, and endline surveys are essential tools in MEL processes for any program or project. Baseline surveys establish the initial conditions of a program, while midline surveys assess the program's progress and any changes since the baseline. Endline surveys, on the other hand, provide a final evaluation of the program's outcomes and impact.

These surveys enable program managers to track changes over time, identify factors that contribute to success or failure, and inform program design and implementation decisions. They also provide stakeholders with important feedback on the effectiveness of the program and help justify the allocation of resources. Adroit's baseline, midline, and endline survey services are designed to help our clients improve the quality and impact of their programs, promote accountability, and enhance learning and adaptation.
